


Seafood and Maritime have designed the Training Calendar to help you fit your studies and lifestyle around your training and assessment needs.

Mix and Match

You can choose multiple ways to complete your qualification:

- Face to Face Training = Attend all Training Days. (Does not have to be in the same block of training. You can spread this out over the year if you wish).
- Please note – Approximately 70% of the face to face training will take place on our two training vessels. Days are scheduled below.
- Combination of Face to Face and Distance - Choose which units you want to attend and do the rest at home or in the workplace.
- Recognition of Prior Learning and Credit Transfers + a combination of above. You will still need to complete the practical components of your selected qualification.

All assessments must be submitted for marking and have a result of Competent before you will be admitted into the practical components of your qualification.
